The foregoing conduct is an unclassified felony offense contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 2: Attempted Murder in the First Degree AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) (CTN 009)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON, with intent to cause the death of another person, engaged in conduct which constituted a substantial step toward the commission of
