THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

**Count 1: Attempted Murder in the First Degree
AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) (CTN 001)**

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON, with intent to cause the death of another person, engaged in conduct which constituted a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree by discharging a firearm at Juneau Police Officer Lee Phelps. The foregoing conduct is an unclassified felony offense contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

**Count 2: Attempted Murder in the First Degree
AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) (CTN 009)**

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON, with intent to cause the death of another person, engaged in conduct which constituted a substantial step toward the commission of

murder in the first degree by discharging a firearm at Juneau Police Officer Darin Schultz. The foregoing conduct is an unclassified felony offense contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 3: Attempted Murder in the First Degree
AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) (CTN 010)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON, with intent to cause the death of another person, engaged in conduct which constituted a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree by discharging a firearm at Juneau Police Detective Brandon Lawrenson. The foregoing conduct is an unclassified felony offense contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 4: Attempted Murder in the First Degree
AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) (CTN 011)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON, with intent to cause the death of another person, engaged in conduct which constituted a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree by discharging a firearm at Juneau Police Detective Krag Campbell. The foregoing conduct is an unclassified felony offense contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 5: Attempted Murder in the First Degree
AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) (CTN 006)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON, with intent to cause the death of another person, engaged in conduct which constituted a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree by discharging a firearm at Juneau Police Officer Joseph Heynen. The foregoing conduct is an unclassified felony offense contrary to and in

violation of AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 6: Attempted Murder in the First Degree
AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) (CTN 004)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON, with intent to cause the death of another person, engaged in conduct which constituted a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree by discharging a firearm at Juneau Police Sergeant Christopher Gifford. The foregoing conduct is an unclassified felony offense contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.100(a)(1) and AS 11.31.100(a) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 7: Misconduct Involving Weapons in the Second Degree
AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(B) (CTN 002)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON knowingly discharged a firearm at or in the direction of a dwelling. The foregoing conduct is a class B felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(B) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 8: Misconduct Involving Weapons in the Second Degree
AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(B) (CTN 015)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON knowingly discharged a firearm at or in the direction of a dwelling. The foregoing conduct is a class B felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(B) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 9: Misconduct Involving Weapons in the Second Degree
AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(A) (CTN 016)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON knowingly discharged a firearm at or in the direction of a building with reckless disregard for a risk of physical injury to a person. The foregoing conduct is a class B felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 10: Misconduct Involving Weapons in the Second Degree
AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(A) (CTN 017)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON knowingly discharged a firearm at or in the direction of a building with reckless disregard for a risk of physical injury to a person. The foregoing conduct is a class B felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 11: Misconduct Involving Weapons in the Second Degree
AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(A) (CTN 018)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON knowingly discharged a firearm at or in the direction of a building with reckless disregard for a risk of physical injury to a person. The foregoing conduct is a class B felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 12: Misconduct Involving Weapons in the Second Degree
AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(A) (CTN 019)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON knowingly discharged a firearm at or in the direction of a building with reckless disregard for a risk of physical injury to a person. The foregoing conduct is a class B felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 13: Assault in the Third Degree
AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(a) (CTN 012)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON recklessly placed another person, JPD Detective Brian Dallas, in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument, a firearm. The foregoing conduct is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 14: Assault in the Third Degree
AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(a) (CTN 013)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON recklessly placed another person, JPD Sergeant Dominic Branson, in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument, a firearm. The foregoing conduct is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 15: Assault in the Third Degree
AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(a) (CTN 014)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON recklessly placed another person, JPD Lieutenant David Campbell in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument, a firearm. The foregoing conduct is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 16: Assault in the Third Degree
AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(a) (CTN 023)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON recklessly placed another person, JPD

Officer Nick Garza, in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument, a firearm. The foregoing conduct is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 17: Assault in the Third Degree
AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(a) (CTN 024)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON recklessly placed another person, JPD Officer Jeremy Weske in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument, a firearm. The foregoing conduct is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 18: Assault in the Third Degree
AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(a) (CTN 025)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON recklessly placed another person, JPD Officer Shawn Phelps in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument, a firearm. The foregoing conduct is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 19: Criminal Mischief in the Third Degree
AS 11.46.482(a)(1) (CTN 008)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON with intent to damage property of another damaged property of Juneau Police Department in an amount greater than \$500. The foregoing conduct is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.46.482(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 20: Criminal Mischief in the Third Degree
AS 11.46.482(a)(1) (CTN 020)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON with intent to damage property of another damaged property of Theodore Quinn in an amount greater than \$500. The foregoing conduct is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.46.482(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 21: Misconduct Involving Weapons in the Fourth Degree
AS 11.61.210(a)(1) (CTN 021)


That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON knowingly possessed on his person a firearm when his physical or mental condition was impaired as a result of the introduction of an intoxicating liquor or a controlled substance into his body. The foregoing conduct is a class A misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.61.210(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count 22: Misconduct Involving Weapons in the Fourth Degree
AS 11.61.210(a)(2) (CTN 022)

That on or about the 7th day of April, 2012, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, TROY A. WILSON knowingly discharged a firearm from, on, or across a highway. The foregoing conduct is a class A misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.61.210(a)(2) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.
