ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2014-06

An Ordinance Transferring Responsibility for the Juneau-Douglas City Museum From the Parks and Recreation Department to the Library Department.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City and Borough of Juneau Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Section. CBJ 03.10.040 Parks and recreation department, is amended to read:

03.10.040 Parks and recreation department.

The parks and recreation department shall be responsible for:

- (1) The supervision and operation of recreation programs and for the maintenance and operation of parks and recreation facilities;
- (2) The maintenance and operation of Centennial Hall, municipal parking lots, the Youth Center, public cemeteries, ~~the museum~~, and other facilities as assigned in writing by the manager;
- (3) Maintenance of all municipal buildings which are not the responsibility of another department or a board of directors.

1 **Section 3. Amendment of Section.** CBJ 03.10.075 Library department, is
2 amended to read:

3 **03.10.075 Library department.**

4 The library department shall be responsible for:

5 (1) Operating, maintaining, and improving the City and Borough library system
6 *and the museum;*

7 (2) Providing and maintaining library materials and information services to
8 support the reading, information, and independent learning needs of the Juneau public;

9 (3) *Providing and maintaining museum artifacts to support the preservation of*
10 *Juneau's history;*

11 ~~(34)~~ Administering state, federal, and foundation grants that benefit library
12 operations and services;

13 (45) Administering library participation in consortia and networks that enhance
14 library services to the Juneau public; and

15 ~~(56)~~ Other related services as assigned by the manager.
