To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to advise of a procedural change the Juneau Police Department (JPD) will be making when dealing with legally licensed marijuana being transported via the Juneau International Airport.

Upon being notified by the Transportation Safety Administration (TSA) screeners of an airline passenger who claims to be a State-registered Marijuana Establishment and is in possession of commercial marijuana, a JPD officer will inspect the passenger's Marijuana Handler Permit Card and Transport Manifest to assure the passenger has followed proper marijuana transportation protocol and is legally authorized to transport marijuana products in accordance with 3 AAC 306.750 Transportation. The officer will then complete the Juneau International Airport Commercial Marijuana Transport Log, documenting the date of travel, name of handler, flight number, Marijuana Handler Card number, and Manifest Transport Number.

The Marijuana Transport Log will be kept in a secure location but will be available to designated commercial airline personnel upon request. The Juneau Police Department will no longer verbally notify airline personnel of a passenger who is traveling with marijuana pursuant to 3 AAC 306.750 Transportation.

This procedure will be effective starting on February 15, 2018.
