STATEMENT OF POINTS ON APPEAL [Appellate Rule 602(c)(1)(A)]

The City of Valdez ("Appellant"), through its counsel, Brena, Bell & Walker, P.C., pursuant to Rule of Appellate Procedure 602(c)(1)(A), hereby files its Points on Appeal with respect to its appeal to the Superior Court from Regulatory Commission of Alaska ("RCA") Order P-19-017(6), dated March 12, 2020 ("Order 6").

- 1. The RCA erred in its interpretation of AS 42.06.445(c).
- 2. The RCA erred in holding that AS 42.06.445(c) is grounds for its Order 6 ruling that certain financial statements filed with the RCA¹ shall be confidential and not subject to public disclosure.

3. The RCA erred in advising Harvest Alaska, LLC ("Harvest Alaska") and BP

Pipelines (Alaska) Inc. ("BPPA") that filed Financial Statements might be entitled to

confidential treatment under AS 42.06.445(c), even though a request for confidential treatment

under that statute had not been asserted and Harvest Alaska and BPPA had failed to submit the

Financial Statements to the RCA with the required confidentiality legend stating: "Confidential

Pursuant to AS 42.06.445(c)."

4. The RCA erred in failing to hold that Harvest Alaska and BPPA had waived the

claim of confidentiality under AS 42.06.445(c).

5. The RCA erred in holding that all of the Financial Statements filed by Harvest

Alaska and BPPA in Dockets P-19-015, P-19-016, P-19-017, and P-19-019 relate to the

finances or operations of a pipeline subject to federal jurisdiction.

6. The RCA erred in holding that AS 42.06.445(c) is applicable to all Financial

Statements filed by Harvest Alaska and BPPA with the RCA in Dockets P-19-015, P-19-016,

P-19-017, and P-19-019, based in part upon the RCA's conclusion that the Financial Statements

are not required to be filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

7. The RCA erred in broadly rather than narrowly interpreting AS 42.06.445(c), as

an exception to the general rule allowing public access to documents filed with the RCA, in

violation of fundamental rights under the Alaska and United States Constitutions, thereby

impeding transparency and the right to question, investigate, and monitor the discharge of the

RCA's duties.
