Situation Assessment: The 14 and 7 day case rates are at the low alert level. Four variants of concern have been identified in Juneau - (Alpha/B.1.1.7, Beta/B.1.351, Gamma/P1, and Delta/B.1.617.2/AY.1). Variants appear to be contained but the public is reminded to follow appropriate precautions when traveling. Cases are increasing slightly in most areas statewide.

Issues of Note:

Effective on July 6th, the Emergency Operations Center will reduce the frequency of the EOC report to once a week. With the exception of State holidays, the COVID-19 dashboard will be updated M-F and the CBJ Risk Metrics dashboard will be updated M, W and F. Social media posts, case count information releases, and other COVID communications will continue as currently scheduled.

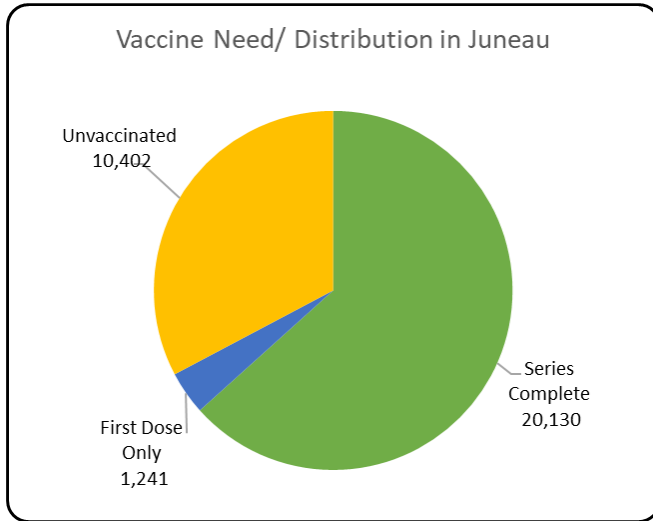

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

We are reporting 2 new resident case2 and 3 new nonresident cases. 2 cases are secondary infection, 2 cases are Travel related, and 1 case is under investigation.

That State is reporting 109 new cases within the past 3 days bringing the statewide total to 71,384 cases.

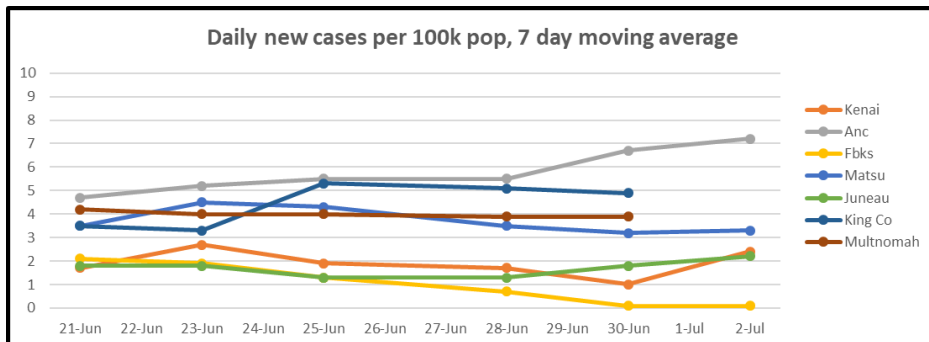
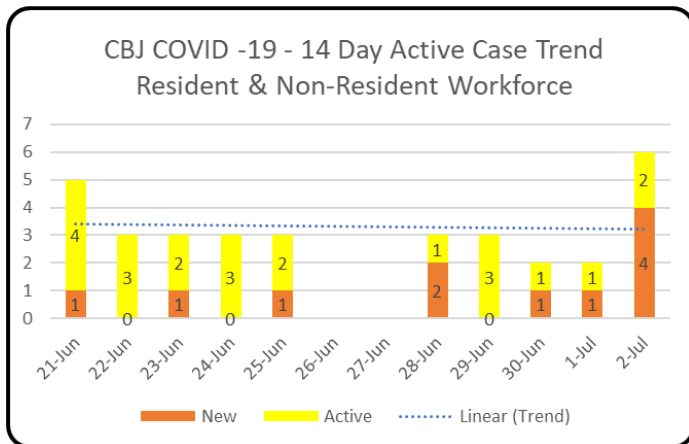
68 COVID tests were processed through BRH since the last EOC report, all with less than 24 hour turnaround



Total: **67.3%** of the of the total population of Juneau has received at least 1 dose of vaccine and **63.4%** have completed their vaccine series.

12+: **78.4%** of the age eligible Juneau population has received at least 1 dose of vaccine. **73.8%** have completed their vaccine series.

65+: **91%** of this age group has at least one dose of vaccine. **88%** have completed the vaccine series. (State updated dashboard)



This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (<https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/>) and generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting.
