**SURCHARGES AND COSTS.**

- Police Training Surcharge: Per case. Due in 10 days:

For offenses on or after 1/1/19:  \$100 (Misd)  \$20 (Infrac./Viol./No Jail Misd)  \$0 (Fine under \$30)
- Initial Jail Surcharge—SOA Cases Only. \$50 per case. Due \_\_\_\_\_.
- Suspended Jail Surcharge: \$100 per case with \$100 suspended. Surcharge must be paid if probation is revoked and, in connection, defendant is arrested and taken to jail or is sentenced to jail.
- Cost of Imprisonment—CBJ Cases Only (\$53 per day served): \$ 1,500.00.
- Cost of court-appointed counsel: \$ 200 Good cause  has  has not been shown to order the defendant to pay an amount different from the amount in Criminal Rule 39(d). Due now. Interest accrues on the judgment at the rate specified in AS 09.30.070(a) from the date of judgment until paid. You must apply for the PFD every year eligible until this cost is paid in full.
- NO CONTACT.** Effective immediately, and until unconditional discharge, defendant will have no direct or indirect contact with: J.B. [If convicted of a sex offense crime (AS 12.63.100) or a domestic violence crime (AS 18.66.990), no-contact with the victim is presumed, unless the court finds on the record that contact is necessary.]

- RESTITUTION.** Make restitution  as stated in the Restitution Judgment  in an amount to be determined per Criminal Rule 32.6(c)(2). Apply for an Alaska Permanent Fund Dividend, if eligible, every year until restitution is paid in full. If placed on probation, failure to pay restitution as ordered is a violation of probation conditions.

- ANGER MANAGEMENT.** Contact Gastineau Human Services (GHS) at 780-3044 by \_\_\_\_\_. Pay for and complete anger management classes and comply with recommendations.
- PED SUPERVISION.**  Concludes now.  Continues until remand.

Stay away from 1) The Nugget Mall & 2) Heritage Coffee at 9112 Mendonhall Mall Rd.

  - Do not possess, consume or buy alcohol at all  during probation  for a period of \_\_\_\_\_  days  years from the date of this judgment. Any new license or state ID must list the alcohol buying restriction until the restriction expires.

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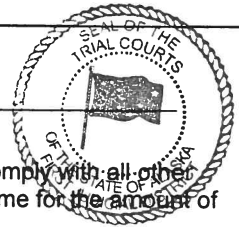

That on or about June 13, 2022, at or near Juneau, in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, Anthony M Migliaccio did, with the intent to harass or annoy another person, subject another person to an offensive physical contact, to wit: MIGLIACCO threw a cup of feces at Jade Blackwell, an employee working at the Heritage Coffee shop. All of which is a Class A Misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation of CBJ 42.20.110(a)(5) and against the peace and dignity of the City and Borough of Juneau.

1 This complaint is based on the observation and written report of Officer Ron Shriver of the  
2 Juneau Police Department, which states, to wit:

3  
4 1. On or about June 13, 2022 at approximately 1421 hours, Amanda Carson  
5 contacted the Juneau Police Department to report that a man in a blue jump suit threw  
6 feces on a Barista at the Heritage Coffee shop on Mendenhall Mall Road.

7 2. Officer Shriver responded to the store and contacted Alison Ford. Ford  
8 explained that there was a homeless man in a blue jump suit that comes into the shop  
9 every day who she thought might be named Anthony. She thought he might have  
10 mental health issues but had never caused a problem before that day. Earlier in the  
11 day he had come up to the counter and told Ford that there was something that she  
12 needed to see, however Ford was busy and didn't have time to go over and look at  
13 whatever it was he wanted to show her. The man left and returned moments later with  
14 a cup, throwing its contents at another employee, Jade Blackwell, striking her in the  
15 face. The contents turned out to be feces, though it was unknown whether it originally  
16 belonged to a human or other animal.

17 3. Officer Shriver then spoke with Blackwell who was still emotional as a  
18 result of the incident. She stated that the feces had originally left a mark on her face  
19 but that she had cleaned it off. Blackwell wanted to pursue charges for harassment.  
20 Blackwell described the individual as a man wearing a blue jumpsuit and backpack with  
21 dark hair and beard. Ford then told Shriver that she'd work with her supervisor to try  
22 and obtain video of the incident.

23 4. Dispatch advised that around the same time of the incident, 911 received  
24 a call from someone who seemed to be having mental health issues before they  
25 disconnected. Dispatch then sent Shriver a photo of the person they believed to have  
26 been responsible for the call. The photo was of ANTHONY MIGLIACCO who was  
27 identified to be the suspect in the feces throwing case.

5. Officer Shriver tried to search the area but was unable to locate  
MIGLIACCO. Shriver also tried contacting him via the telephone number he had called  
dispatch with, but was also unsuccessful. However around 1542 hours Shriver located

1 MIGLIACCO wearing the blue jumpsuit and backpack and made contact with him near  
2 Lyle's and Jensen's Home Furnishings. Shriver questioned him about what had  
3 happened earlier at the coffee shop and why he had called 911.

4 6. MIGLIACCO stated in essence that he believed something was going on  
5 with social media and that people were trying to get him in trouble regarding the feces  
6 he had found on the ground. He went on to say that he had pointed out the poop to  
7 staff before leaving, then claimed to have picked it up to show the staff before later  
8 tossing it. MIGLIACCO denied throwing it at anyone.

9 7. Several days later on June 15, 2022, Shriver obtained the video from  
10 Heritage. Upon review MIGLIACCO was seen throwing what appeared to be feces at  
11 Blackwell, striking her in the face.
