STATEMENT OF FACTS IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION FOR BAIL REVIEW HEARING


The State of Alaska, by and through Assistant District Attorney Jessalyn Gillum, submits the following statement of facts as a basis for its request to review Defendant Jeffrey Fultz's bail and conditions of release:

- 1. Defendant Jeffrey Fultz (hereinafter "Defendant") currently stands accused of eight (8) counts of Sexual Assault in the Second Degree under AS 11.41.420(a)(4) (hereinafter referred to as "Sexual Assault") and one count of Harassment in the First Degree under AS 11.61.118(a)(2) (hereinafter referred to as "Harassmen").
- 2. These charges arose from allegations provided by seven (7) complaining witnesses and involves conduct spanning from 2014 through 2020.

small towel, roughly the size of a tea towel/washcloth, to use to cover their naked bodies, which barely covered their breasts.

- 12. Multiple complaining witnesses allege that at some point during the session the towel would fall off of their bodies and Defendant would interfere when they went to pick it up or requested it be handed to them, stating that "sheets get in the way."

 The session would then continue with the women laying fully naked.
- 13. Defendant is alleged to have touched either the breast tissue, buttock area, and inner thigh/vaginal area, or some combination thereof, of each of the complaining witnesses, often on more than one occasion.
- 14. At least two complaining witnesses describe placing their hand in the way of Defendant's hands during a session so as to prevent him from touching either breast tissue or genitalia, and that Defendant would attempt to force his way past their hands. On at least one occasion he succeeded in pushing past a patient's hand to continue touching her breasts.
- 15. Multiple complaining witnesses state that they were aware that Defendant was sexually aroused, either by feeling or observing his erection, during these sessions.
- 16. Six out of the seven complaining witnesses are members of the native community in Alaska. The seventh complaining witness was a colleague of the Defendant's at SEARHC, and had begun treating with him after an informal discussion where Defendant offered to help her with her back and hip pain.
- 17. When questioned by Detective Daniel Darbonne, Defendant referenced an allegation he faced in Arizona in 2011 where he was accused of improper touching, also while serving at a facility that focused on the native population.
- 18. In the course of the investigation two eye witnesses were identified; one who was a former employee and another who was the husband of one of the complaining witnesses. Both are alleged to have observed Defendant behaving in a manner they

- On April 8, 2021, Defendant was indicted on three (3) counts of Sexual Assault and one (1) count of Harassment based on the outcries of three complaining witnesses: C.A.L., C.E.L., and M.W.
- 4. At arraignment on April 30, 2021, the Court set Defendant's bail at \$25,000.00 cash only appearance bond, permitted Defendant to reside in Santa Fe, NM (his location at the time of his arrest), and instructed him to have no contact with the alleged victims or unsupervised contact with any patients. He was also required to surrender his passport and sign a waiver of extradition before being released.
- 5. Following the indictment becoming public on or around April 8, 2021, additional individuals came forward with new allegations against Defendant.
- 6. On June 3, 2021 a Juneau Grand Jury indicted Defendant on five (5) additional counts of Sexual Assault involving four complaining witnesses: C.W., R.F., Y.R.F., R.P., and M. S.
- 7. Defendant stands accused of using his position as a trusted doctor within the SEARHC facility to sexually assault his patients under the guise of providing legitimate chiropractic treatment and massage therapy.
- 8. He is alleged to have ordered the complaining witnesses to fully undress for their appointments, regardless of their symptoms or complaints, which ranged from back and hip pain to bilateral thumb pain.
- 9. In several instances he is alleged to have remained in the room after directing the complaining witnesses to disrobe, or to leave the room and return abruptly to interrupt a patient as she undressed.
- 10. When asked why disrobing was necessary, Defendant is alleged to have responded that "clothes get in the way."
- 11. Several of the complaining witnesses state that after complying with Defendant's instruction they realized there was no sheet or gown to use to cover their bodies. Upon requesting a sheet or gown, these women state that Defendant offered only a
