
LANDSCAPER GETS AID FROM CITY IN SLIDE CLEAN-UP

Supplementing the landscaping efforts of Scotty McClellan, the city yesterday started a crew of men at work cleaning up the debris left on the South Franklin Street hillside above the cold storage caused by last fall's slide.

Clearing away of stumps, logs, old lumber, and other refuse is going on apace, and it is expected that soon the worst traces of the avalanche will have disappeared.

But, primary efforts toward beautifying the site must be credited to Longshoreman McClellan, who, with rock slabs gathered from the slide heap has terraced off the face of the pile toward the street around his cabin, has put in his garden, and laid in a winter's supply of wood by bucking many of the logs and stumps. The McClellan cabin was narrowly missed by the slide, and is now the only dwelling occupying the gash.
