

THIRD SLIDE ACTION FILED AGAINST A-J

Fred Mattson Seeks Dam- ages for Loss of His Wife, Property

The third in a series of actions against the Alaska Juneau Gold Mining Company, arising out of the November earthslide, was today filed in Federal District Court, by Fred Mattson.

Mr. Mattson asks \$35,946.50 in damages for the death of his wife and loss of property. Henry Roden and Albert White are attorneys for Mr. Mattson.

The plaintiff bases his action on similar charges to those made by Gust Erickson and George J. Jee, in their suits previously filed against the company. His charges are, namely, that the mining company was negligent in its care of the hillside which slid down upon Lower Franklin street, destroying several buildings and reaping a toll of 15 lives.
