
2 BIG SLIDES AT SALMON CREEK ROAD BLOCKED

Bridge Reported Still in But
Damaged—Only Pas-
sage Now by Foot

Two big slides at Salmon Creek and several smaller ones along the Glacier Highway blocked that artery of traffic last night and today. The first avalanche, about 100 feet wide, came down on the west side of the Salmon Creek bridge Saturday night and blocked the roads, tying many autos up on the far side. Sunday another slide came down above the bridge and filled the creek channel, causing the water to sweep over the John Wagner place and across the road in a torrent on the town side of the span.

The bridge itself had not gone out this morning, it was reported, but some of the underpinning was damaged and the only means of passage was by foot. A crew from the Bureau of Public Roads this morning cut a channel through the highway for the water to go through and it probably will be days before the highway will be passable again.
